We ask that parents do not remove their skaters off the ice until class ends and the coaches have let them off. If there are any concerns the coach will wave you down to come take your child off the ice.
- Please make sure to send skaters in warm clothes and mitts that are not fuzzy, as they stick to the ice. Make sure skates are tightly done up and helmet it on securely.
